### Flight Qualification of the Head Down Display

Miltech Hellas S.A. (Koropi, Greece) has successfully completed the Flight Qualification tests of the new Head Down Display HD-55L that was developed for the Mirage 2000 EG/BG fighter of the Hellenic Air Force during the period May 18-20 at the 114th Fighter Wing Tanagra Air Force Base.

The HDD-55L was thoroughly tested on both 1-seat and 2-seat Mirage 2000 aircraft, during Day & Night flights and under extreme environmental conditions. The new Head Down Display utilizes the latest Active Matrix Liquid Crystal Display (AMLCD) technology and is a direct replacement of the existing Cathode-Ray Tube units, which experience obsolescence and reliability issues. The AMLCD display provides both stroke graphics and high-resolution video and no modifications are required to the Mirage 2000 or associated aircraft systems.

The flight qualification trials pave the way for the production & delivery of 32 units to the Hellenic Air Force, along with automatic test equipment that was designed to support the new displays.

The company looks forward to offer this display as a cost-effective upgrade to other Mirage 2000 users worldwide
